For the next month, the **Vancouver Symphony Orchestra** (VSO) is offering a somewhat eclectic and unexpected line-up. Not the least of which is "Bugs Bunny at the Symphony," conducted and created by George Daugherty, Nov. 19 and 20. This experience features showing the classic Warner Bros. "Looney Tunes" on a big screen, with the exhilarating original scores played live in the beautiful Orpheum Theatre.

There are also opportunities to absorb the passion and power of Russian classics during a performance on Nov. 24, or take the kids to a special children's concert performance on Nov. 27, called "Tchaikovsky Discovers America," featuring a fictional tale about the great Russian composer's musical journey to Niagara Falls.


Another not-to-be-missed performance by the VSO is the breathtaking, epic choral masterpiece Brahms "Requiem," featuring vocals by the beautiful and superbly talented soprano Isabel Bayrakdarian (pictured, right), as well as the Vancouver Bach Choir, on Dec. 3 and 5. Bayrakdarian is admired as much for her stunning stage presence as for her exceptional voice. She burst onto the international opera scene after winning first prize in the 2000 Operalia competition founded by Plácido Domingo, and has since performed in many of the world's major opera houses and concert halls.






